

## CENTRAL MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND

**PROPOSAL:** Band Tour

**DATES:** Friday, March 22, 2019 – Tuesday, March 26, 2019

**NUMBER OF DIRECTORS:** 2

**NUMBER OF STUDENTS:** 110

**COST OF TRIP:** \$1,250.00

Conditions for a “YES” vote:

1. Each parent agrees to be responsible for the total cost of the child/children of \$1,200.00 to \$1,300.00 per person when voting “yes”. They agree that their child’s participation in this tour is not dependent on their child raising part or any amount of funds needed for this tour. Each parent agrees to pay a \$250.00 deposit on or before August 16, 2018. The second deposit of \$250.00 will be due on November 1, 2018. **These deposits and the balance are non-refundable if your child cannot attend.** Deposits will be refunded only if the child earns through quota system the entire cost of the tour. The final remaining balance of the tour will be due on March 1, 2019.
2. A fundraiser will be provided in order for students to help defray the cost of the tour. A quota system will be used. Example: A student will be given 100% credit on the profit from each fundraiser. Therefore, if the profit is 50% and the student brings in \$400 from one or a combination of the fundraisers, they will have earned a \$200 credit. If a student has earned credit but cannot attend the tour, the District #146 Band Parent Association retains their money credit.

**NOTE:** Article IX-Section 2 of the By-Laws District #146 Band Parents Association states that when students are participating in a fundraiser for the purpose of subsidizing a tour, the **first \$35** profit of any money raised during the school year will go into the general fund. This amount may be adjusted annually by the District #146 Band Parents Association.

3. The parents will be asked to vote for this proposal. The voting results must be 85% or higher in favor of the tour for it to take place. Only those students who have participated in summer band, meet the performance standards, point requirement (see handbook on page 6), abide by the CMS school handbook behavior code, and demonstrate loyalty (through their presence, punctuality and wholehearted participation as deemed important by the directors) will be allowed to participate in this event.
4. Directors will select and organize chaperones subject to the School Board’s approval.

5. The District 146 Band Parents Association will be in charge of all fundraisers.
6. A parent can pay the entire cost of the tour for their child/children and not be required to participate in the fundraising. A deposit of \$250.00 is due on August 16, 2018 with the second deposit of \$250.00 due on November 1, 2018. **The deposit and balance is non-refundable if a child cannot attend.** The final balance is due on or before March 1, 2019. Please understand the reservation deposits and transportation costs must be paid in advance. Please make checks payable to the **District #146 Band Parents Associations.**
7. Parents wishing to be in Orlando on their own and have their child join them can do so only on Tuesday, March 26, 2019. There will be no reduction in cost for doing this due to tickets/vouchers and means of transportation being non-refundable. Written notification must be given to the directors by March 1, 2019.
8. Parents agree to all rules and regulations established by the band department and District 146 for the welfare and safety of their child. A complete packet of information will be given to each family that will include general information, rules for students, personal checklist, restrictions, student performance requirements and chaperone-student guidelines.
